

# Wait for reopening of Jamia likely to end soon

NEW DELHI, FEB 12 --/ Thelongo wait for resumption of offline classes at the Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) may end soon with the administration planning to issue a notification on this likely by Sunday. Though a tentative date for reopening

of the campus is not known yet, Waseem Ahmad Khan, chief proctor of the university, said it would open in a phased manner. On courses that would be given priority for physical classes, Khan said PhD scholars whose submission dates are

near and students in courses that require practical classes would be called first. After the Delhi Disaster Management Authority issued guidelines to reopen all schools and colleges, several universities, including JNU and Delhi

University, have announced resumption of offline classes. The Jamia Millia Islamia, however, is yet to make an announcement in this connection. The Left-affiliated All India Students' Association, along with other student outfits and JMI students, has staged protests, demanding reopening of the campus. The notification regarding the reopening of the university will be issued soon, probably by Sunday, Khan told PTI. "The notification will have all the information regarding the reopening of the university. It will be clarified what courses are reopening in the first phase and in the second. Moreover, the date will also be notified," he said. "In the first phase, as said by the vice-chancellor, we will give priority to PhD scholars who are in their last year, physiotherapy students, dentistry and final-year students. The course that requires practical classes will be given priority," Khan said. On the mode of examination, he said that if classes are held offline, then exams too will take place offline. (PTI)

# Poll campaigning ends in Uttarakhand

DEHRADUN, FEB 12 --/ Campaigning came to an end on Saturday for the 70 Assembly seats of Uttarakhand going to polls on February 14 with a host of star campaigners, including Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Union home minister Amit Shah, Uttar Pradesh chief minister Yogi Adityanath and Congress general secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra, holding a series of rallies in support of their p a r t y candidates. Electioneering, which drew to a close at 6 pm in accordance with the Election commission's (EC) guidelines, was affected for the most part by Covid-19 restrictions, including a ban on physical rallies, forcing the political parties to resort to virtual rallies and scaled-down door-to-door campaigns. However, the ban on physical rallies was lifted in a phased manner by the EC from February 1 onwards. Polling is scheduled to be held to the 70 Assembly seats spread over 13 districts on Monday and the counting of votes will be taken up on March 10. On the last day of campaigning, Modi held a rally in Rudrapur.

Adityanath in Tehri and Kottwar, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh in Kapkot, Salt and Ramnagar, while Shah addressed rallies in Dhanolti, Sahaspur and Raipur, besides taking part in a door-to-door campaign in Haridwar and performing a puja at Har ki Pauri.

At the Rudrapur rally, the Prime Minister appealed to the people of the state not to let the Congress's "agenda of appeasement" succeed in the election, describing it as an opportunity for them to wipe out the opposition party that has already been uprooted from many states. Priyanka Gandhi, at her rallies in Khatima and Haldwani, raised the issues of inflation, unemployment and the plight of farmers. She alleged that the three agriculture laws that led to a year-long farmers' protest were meant to bring more prosperity to Modi's

billionaire industrialist friends at the cost of the farmers. The Congress leader also accused the BJP government in Uttarakhand of giving three chief ministers in five years and doing nothing for the people of the state. "They have no experience of running governments, so they changed chief ministers in quick succession," she said. Priyanka Gandhi also reminded the voters of the

salient features of the Congress manifesto, which promises to give employment to four lakh people by filling up the vacancies in the government and raising a tourist police force, not letting the price of an LPG cylinder exceed Rs 500, reserving 40 per cent of the jobs in the police force for women and free travel for women in roadways buses.
